

# OLSH College Uniform Policy

When travelling to and from school, students must wear correct school uniform. In hot weather the summer uniform may be worn without a blazer. The school jumper may not be worn as an outer garment in place of the blazer.

# ALL ITEMS OF UNIFORM MUST BE CLEARLY NAMED.

Length of dress: These should reach the knee when standing.

**Hair:** must be taken off the face and, if it reaches shoulder length, to be tied back neatly with a navy or white ribbon. Extremes of hair style or colour are not permitted. Coloured beads and braids may not be worn in the hair.

**Jewellery:** Only a wristwatch may be worn and/or two pairs of silver or gold studs or small sleepers in the lobe of pierced ears. Facial piercings are not permitted. No makeup or any form of nail polish may be worn with the school uniform.

Badges: Only OLSH badges may be worn.

**Sports Uniform:** During the school day correct sports uniform can only be worn for PE/Dance lessons. Items of sports uniform are not part of normal school day wear. Sports socks, tracksuits or the OLSH sports tops are to be worn only with sports uniform. For Occupational Health and Safety reasons canvas shoes and basketball style boots are not permitted.

Students may wear their sports uniform to school only on the day on which they have their practical PE or Dance classes. Outside scheduled classes the wearing of the sports uniform is not permitted. Should there be a variance to this, parents will be notified.

Socks: must be regulation school socks and are to be worn clearly above the ankle.

**Shoes:** should be plain black lace-up style. T-Bars, thick platform soles, high heels, suede shoes, gold/ silver buckles, etc. <u>are not acceptable</u>. If in doubt, seek advice before purchasing new shoes.

**Stickers and graffiti:** are not acceptable on the school bag or on books. Planners deemed defaced will need to be replaced at the student's cost.

**OLSH satchel:** The OLSH satchel must be worn on school excursions when the girls are in school uniform.

# **OLSH College Sunsmart Policy**

This SunSmart Policy has been developed to ensure that all students and staff attending OLSH College are protected from over-exposure to the harmful ultraviolet rays of the sun.

- A SunSmart hat is part of the uniform.
- All students are encouraged to use 30+ sunscreen.

- All students should wear their SunSmart hat and College sports polo top to PE classes from September to April.
- All students are required to wear suitable hats, clothing and sunscreen to excursions and camps.

All students are encouraged to use sunscreen and to wear hats or to sit under shade at recess and lunch time particularly in Terms 1 and 4.

### **UNIFORM INFRINGEMENTS**

Students who are out of uniform will incur a uniform infringement warning. Upon the second breach for the semester students will be issued with a uniform detention. These are held every Thursday

after school from 3.30pm to 4.30pm. Students are permitted to bring school work to do during this time.

An automatic detention will be issued to students who wear their jumper without a blazer to or from school and students who wear their PE Uniform on the incorrect day.
